

RESOLUTION NO. 1666

WHEREAS, at the special election for Thurston County Fire Protective District No. 3 held at Lacey, Washington, April 2, 1949, a proposition was presented as follows: "Shall a Fire Protection District be formed, as set forth in a petition signed by 683 registered voters of the district, and approved by the Thurston County Commissioners by Resolution No. 1655, the legal description of proposed district having been advertised and posted as required by law.

WHEREAS, a total of 483 votes were cast for and against said proposition, 440 votes being for the said proposition and 43 votes against the said proposition.

WHEREAS, the following persons were nominated for Fire Commissioners for Thurston County Fire District No. 3: A. G. Homann, Robert Christensen and Emil Johnson; that the three candidates receiving the highest number of votes were as follows: A. G. Homann, 409 votes; Robert Christensen, 386 votes and Emil Johnson, 398 votes.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED:

(1) That the Thurston County Fire District No. 3 be declared established by this Resolution at Lacey, Washington, and as described as follows:

Beginning at the south one-quarter corner of Sec. 1, T.18 N.R. 2 W., W.M., thence east six and one-half miles to the southeast corner of Sec. 1, T.18 N.R. 1 W., W.M., thence north one mile to the northeast corner of Sec. 1, thence east one and one-half miles, more or less, to the Nisqually River, thence southeasterly following the course of the Nisqually River through Sections 5 and 8, in T.18 N.R. 1 E., W.M., to an intersection with the east line of Sec. 8, thence south one and one-half miles, more or less, to the southeast corner of Sec. 17, thence west one-half mile to the south one-quarter corner of Sec. 17, thence south one mile to the south one-quarter corner of Sec. 20, thence west one-half mile to the southwest corner of Sec. 20, thence south one mile to the southeast corner of Sec. 30, thence west one mile to the southwest corner of Sec. 30, thence south two miles along the range line to the southeast corner of Sec. 1, T.17 N.R. 1 W., thence west three miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 3, thence north one-half mile to the west one-quarter corner of Sec. 3, thence west one mile to the west one-quarter corner of Sec. 4, thence north one-half mile to the northwest corner of Sec. 4, thence west along the township line two miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 31, T.18 N.R. 1 W., W.M., thence north along the range line one mile to the northeast corner of Sec. 36, T.18 N.R. 2 W., W.M., thence west one-half mile to the south one-quarter corner of Sec. 25, thence north one mile to the north one-quarter corner of Sec. 25, and an intersection with the corporate limits of Olympia, thence in a general northerly direction following the easterly corporate limits of Olympia to the south one-quarter corner of Sec. 1, T.18 N.R. 2 W., W.M., and the beginning of this description.

(2) That the three candidates receiving the highest number of votes for Fire Commissioners are declared elected to the following terms, to-wit:

A. G. Homann - - - - - six year term  
Emil Johnson - - - - - four year term  
Robert Christensen - - - - - two year term
