Lacey Fire District 3 announces the receipt of a \$21,600 grant from Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation.

The grant will help purchase bunker gear, the protective clothing firefighters must wear when they enter a burning structure. Receipt of this grant allows the purchase of gear to replace numerous pieces that had to be taken out of service due to excessive wear and age. The National Fire Protection Association has determined that bunker gear over 10 years old does not provide a sufficient level of protection to firefighters – this means Lacey Fire District must replace gear due to age as well as damage and excessive wear.

Having this gear is critical and essential to being able to deliver firefighting services, and the generous grant from Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation helps us meet our Mission of Service With Excellence.
