Qualifications & Requirements

- Emergency Medical Technician-Basic Certification, and pass the Thurston County Medic One protocol test within 60 days
- Current CPAT and acceptable FireTEAM test scores
- ICS 100,200 & 700 certificates
- Complete LFD3 application and interview process
- Good driving record & pass a criminal background check & drug screening
- Be able to work at least 3 shifts per month
- Participate in required District Trainings

Preferred (not required)

- IFSAC (or equivalent) Firefighter I certification, with HazMat Operations
